

Keep surfaces clean from Covid-19

SARS-Cov-2 (Coronavirus) surface swab testing services



SARS-Cov-2 is a strain of coronavirus that has caused the Covid-19 outbreak. The virus is predominantly transmitted from person to person via droplets, but it can also be spread from contaminated surfaces through everyday human activity or airborne droplets in building ventilation systems.

The virus can remain airborne for up to 3 hours and survive for days on some surfaces, so a carefully planned strategy for preventing its spread will play a key part in allowing facilities and property managers to reopen premises safely.

As symptoms vary from person to person, and can remain hidden for some time, businesses will have to assume that any number of their returning workforce may have the virus. So the ability to know when surfaces or touchpoints are contaminated will play a significant role in mitigating the spread of the virus and reducing the chances of a second wave.

Protect your people and assess the effectiveness of your mitigation measures

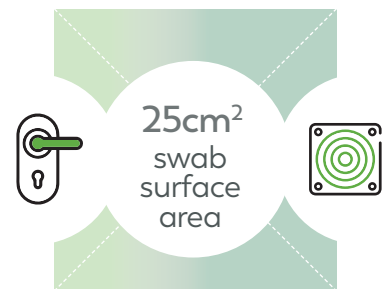
SARS-Cov-2 surface swab tests have been developed to confirm the presence of the virus on environmental surfaces, such as door handles, work surfaces, ventilation system grilles and filters, over a 25cm² area, using a sterile swab pre-moistened with phosphate-buffered saline.

Routine swab tests will help determine, monitor and ultimately strengthen the effectiveness of measures in place to protect the health and safety of your workforce, giving you peace of mind that your environments are operating with best practice in combatting further risk of spreading the virus.

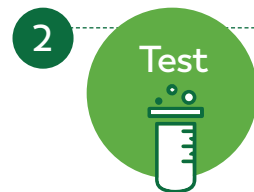
Our expertly trained teams will identify the right locations for SARS-Cov-2 testing within your premises and ensure these tests are taken, transported and analysed safely, and in accordance with World Health Organization protocols.

Test results and certificates confirming the absence or presence of the SARS-Cov-2 virus will be available 72 hours from receipt of the samples at the laboratory, with a further 24 hours should an ID for Covid-19 be required following a positive result.
